  - BC Certificate of Incorporation; and
  - Documentation that qualifying the equipment/device has been purchased and installed (e.g., Bill
    of Sale, insurance documents, lease agreements).
- 4. BCTA will only review fully completed applications from companies that meet the eligibility requirements of the CleanBC Heavy-duty Vehicle Efficiency Program, including, but not limited to, the following:
  - Have a company delegate take and pass the CleanBC Heavy-duty Vehicle Efficiency Program Course at least every 2 years
  - The incentives must be for eligible equipment to be installed on a heavy-duty vehicle (or vehicles) with a gross vehicle weight (GVW) greater than 7,257 kg and operated in BC;
  - All qualifying equipment being applied for, be purchased and installed in BC;
  - The company must conduct business in BC; and
  - The company must have at least one terminal in BC.

Note: Only fuel saving equipment that is purchased and taken possession of during the Program year (September 1, 2024 to August 31, 2025) is eligible for Program rebates.

Membership in BCTA is not required to participate in the Program.

- 5. BCTA will use third-party sources to verify models of qualifying equipment in each application and the estimated fuel savings associated with these models.
- 6. Program Incentive Rebate is not guaranteed and is subject to fund availability (i.e., first come first served as per the Program Guide).
