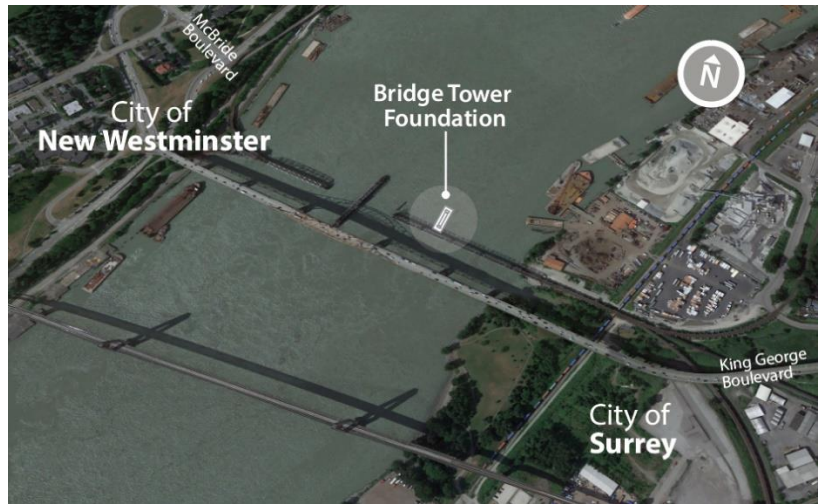




Bridge Foundation Work

February 11, 2021

Subject to final permitting, Fraser Crossing Partners plans to start in-river work on the bridge tower foundation between February 13 and 28. Crews will place rock for bridge foundation protection and install the first piles that will form the foundation for the bridge tower. This initial work will provide additional information on in-river geotechnical conditions, underwater monitoring data and construction methodologies. It will be complete by the end of February in accordance with anticipated Fisheries and Oceans Canada requirements, to minimize impact to fish and fish habitat. Major project construction is scheduled to begin in the coming months.



A tower crane and barges will be used to achieve this work. Weekly updates for marine users regarding in-river construction activities will be posted on pattullobridgereplacement.ca.

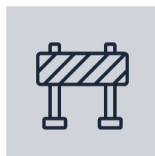


Hours of Work
Intermittent pile driving will occur:
Monday-Friday from 7:00 a.m. – 8:00 p.m.
Saturdays from 9:00 a.m. – 6:00 p.m.

No pile driving activities will take place on Sundays or holidays.



Traffic
There will be no vehicle traffic impacts related to this work.



Impacts/Interruptions
Nearby businesses and residents will hear some noise and may feel some vibration from the intermittent pile driving. As much as possible, a shroud will be used during piling to reduce noise. All general construction activities and other non-pile driving activities (welding, concrete work, etc.) will occur 24 hours a day, seven days a week.
